LESSON 4: DEAD AW'DOM WALKING

Read For This Week's Book Study

Deuteronomy 30: 19-20, Proverbs 8: 32-36, Proverbs 14: 12, John 10: 10, James 1: 15

Memory Scripture: “For to be carnally minded death, but to be spiritually minded, life and peace.” –Romans 8: 6 (KJV)

Key Scripture: “Because the carnal mind enmity against Theós (Hashem/Elohim), for it is not subject to the law of Theós, neither indeed can be. So, then they that are in the flesh cannot please Theós.” –Romans 8: 7-8 (KJV)

Word Study: The Greek word νεκρός *nekrós*, means “death”, “lifeless”, “defunct”, or “departed” while ψόφιος *psófiος* means, “gutless” or “spinless” which typically is applied as an adjective and used metaphorically to degrade someone for having lack of courage or bravery.

Have you ever heard the expression, "Dead man/woman walking?"

This idiom is used for certain occasions, one being for prisoners who are going to be executed as punishment for their crime or a series of crimes. Another way the expression is used is to show someone will certainly lose their job, position, title social status, etc. very soon. Guess what? Until Christ ransomed us from Hell, aw'dom (humanity/human/living being/man/woman/humanity) was defiantly a dead person walking and very much on death row, but what if I told you there is still yet another way aw'dom is still, in fact, a dead man/woman walking? Death has a few meanings in the Book and depending on who you are in the spiritual realm, death is literally your name or your profession. Let's start from the top and go down, shall we?

Physical Death

For all terrestrials, saved or not saved, death is a physical event that separates us from a loved one or a beloved pet. Their bodies “sleep in death” while their nephesh (soul) is required to go to Heaven or Sheol (realm of the dead) and into Hell.

Titles Of Death

There are two parties who bear the title of Death in the spiritual realm. Heaven’s Seraphim (Winged Serpent/Angel) Of Death and the Seraphim Of The Lord. There is a mistranslation of the Seraphim Of Death title. The seraphim at Passover was known as The Destroyer (מַשִּׁית, *mashit*) and this one seraphim is famous for killing the firstborn in Egypt (Exodus 12: 22-36). Yeshua Christ is the Seraphim Of The Lord. You must read Jasher, Enoch and other canon books to see his title revealed as such because later in scripture, the writers do not address his name anymore, they just refer to Yeshua as Seraphim Of The Lord. This is huge because there are several times Yeshua made appearances before he descended to earth and partook in his virgin birth with Mary. He was striking down, cutting down, smiting evil people and binding evil spirits long before his earthy career as a humble servant doing miracles. Yeshua is not a mere agent of death who bears the title. He’s way higher in rank and he defiantly knew how to cause death and take life at the appropriate times.

Then there’s Hell’s fallen version of that, which bears the title, Spirit Of Death. Do not confuse these two roles for Heaven and Hell. One party is holy and being instructed by Elohim to take life on his behalf and to be a symbol of punishment to us mortals in the Torah days. These celestial beings who have this responsibility specifically took life not for pleasure, not for fun, but because that was his/her job and Yahweh had a purpose for physical death in general. The other party is unholy, and has been allowed to be an evil spirit that can legally torment us by their choice or if Yahweh commands them to do so. These evil spirits bear the title of Spirit Of Death and they specialize in creating death-like scenarios or create illusions of death-like symptoms. Meaning,

you go through the valley of the shadow of death, but don't die or physically cannot die, but rest assured, Spirits Of Death will still make you feel like you are dying.

Spiritual Death

The term "second death" occurs four times in the New Testament, specifically in Revelation 2: 11, Revelation 20: 6, Revelation 20: 14 and Revelation 21: 8. According to Revelation 2:11 and Revelation 20: 6, those who overcome Lucifer's tribulations have part in the first resurrection and will not be hurt by the second death, which has no power over them. This type of death is known as "spiritual death". It is not a physical death, is the eternal separation from Elohim should a Christian never repent and return to their Creator and finish the race.

I would like to add onto this and say that the church is full of people who are still very much alive and walking around in their bodies, but scripture tells us that such people are lukewarm and only in the company of the dead and walk a mirage path that appears good to them, but will only lead them down to Sheol, whose company is the dead. These humans are unaware that they are being seduced by Babylon, the Great Whore, the Adulterous, the Seductress and Mother Of All Sin and temptress of all worldly pleasures. Pagans and if we're not careful, us Christians, will be beguiled by her charm and temptations and won't even realize when we lift our gaze to study our reflections in the mirror that there's a skeleton staring at us. Babylon and sin in general will blind people to what is really happening and she always shows us that there is still flesh and blood on our body, but that's her lie to keep us enslaved to her.

Proverbs 9: 17-18 says, *“Stolen waters are sweet and bread in secret is pleasant. But he knoweth not that the dead there, her guests in the depths of Sheol.”*

Proverbs 13: 21 says, *“Evil pursueth sinners, but to the righteous good shall be repaid.”*

Proverbs 5: 3-6 says, *“For the lips of a strange woman drop a honeycomb and her mouth smoother than oil. But her end is bitter as wormwood, sharp as a two edged sword. Her feet go down to death, her steps take hold on Sheol. Lest thou shouldst ponder the path of life, her ways are moveable, thou canst not know.”*

Proverbs 6: 24-26 says, *“To keep thee from the evil woman, from the flattery of the tongue of a strange woman. Lust not after her beauty in thine heart, neither let her take thee with her eyelids. And the adulteress will hunt for the precious life.”*

The adulterous woman or the woman known as Folly in Proverbs is Babylon and Wisdom is Ruwah. Babylon uses mirages to conceal what is happening to the host and if a person is too far gone in their carnal flesh, they're helpless to see that she's staring at them and draining their life source. It's sad when I see pagans die and give into her seduction and deceptions. It's even worse when I see Christians who know they are dead inside and are willing faking their confession of faith, their sanctification and have allowed her to move into their hearts and have evicted the Holy Spirit. For Christians who are claiming they are following Yeshua and think they're something, when they're *psófiós*, gutless and spineless in reality, is such a disservice unto Elohim.

These types of Christians refuse to mature in their faith, like being ignorant simply to avoid convictions, choose security blankets over correction and Elohim's truth and for lack of a better word, are too lazy to lay down their fear of the unknown, pride and come out of their comfort zones to be uncomfortable. Because everyone knows that when we're uncomfortable is when life gets harder. I will be the first to tell you that stepping out of a comfort zone is also a 100% guarantee that pain, frustration and unfairness will meet a person. Maybe even talk that person for the rest of their earthly careers—but fam, that's just a fact of spiritual warfare and walking with the Lord.

Don't get mad, don't take it personal, it's just business and Christians need to toughen up so they can endure it or they will perish, get mad at Elohim and walk away from them, muttering how it's too hard to be a Christian. Quitting our race because it's too hard, trading our salvation for pleasure, giving into our carnal urges and worldly lusts *is not* the ace card you think it is, but sadly Christians who stop growing or straight up refuse to grow experience spiritual death yet again.

Honestly, we are just prey and game to devils, Lucifer and Babylon. If they can't take our physical bodies whenever they wish to do so, that leaves our salvation. If they can harm that or cause us to forsake our Creator for any reason, then they can and will kill us spiritually from the inside. Now, for the next part of our lesson we're going to have a visual demonstration, but I need to tell you about the light part of the demonstration first. There is a renowned painting of Yeshua knocking on a door to come inside a house. This painting represents the human's heart, the house he wishes to abide in, but he cannot enter because there is no door handle so it's up to the human to open the door for him.

Similar to Yeshua knocking on the door, I have a music video that captures the essence of the Proverbs I have provided for this lesson and will show the opposite of what happens if we let the wrong spirit come inside of us. There are several symbols in the music video *Numbers* that I want you to pay close attention to. The hotel room represents the heart of a person, the woman on the bed in hotel room is Babylon. The skull cards she uses represent death and the collection time of a soul. The men she stalks are spiritually dead and forsook their salvation a long time ago and she when she spins the coin on the skull cards, it represents her amusement to see who she will stalk. The wolf necklace she wears reveals that she is a "wolf in sheep's clothing", for she has deceived many, proclaiming to be holy and sent of Elohim, but she is an imposter and no one has put that together. She wears red lipstick and a bright red dress not for romance, but to represent that blood will be shed. Her lips and eyes are the tools she uses to seduce her victims and ultimately, kill them.

When she leaves the hotel room, she goes about the kingdom that Daughter's singer says she is numb in. The singer is representing a man or woman who is "numb" is Lucifer and Babylon's kingdom. As Babylon roams the streets, there are souls about who have their own issues, struggles,

worldly lusts and pleasures. She passes people who believed in her, like the teenager who is wounded on the bench crying out for help, but Babylon ignores her because she is her slave. She enters the bar and is approached by a drunk, an obvious sinner. She entertains him, but doesn't kill him, it's not his time and she doesn't need to worry about him anyway, she knows she has the drunk and can go after him anytime.

There is the young, handsome man who is in bar wearing all blue. This color in the Book represents the law of Elohim, but the young handsome man wearing all blue enjoys the pleasure of the world and isn't in the bar to witness sincerely. He's there to engage with people to casually socialize, but those people are "dead". Babylon approaches the young man and simply stares at him. He immediately sees her and knows who she is, yet doesn't understand what's happening until. Even with the confusion settling in as to why she's sitting there staring at him, he had time to make up his mind, but he doesn't do that and because he choose to remain lukewarm, she took his life that he forfeit with his own actions and poor choices.

Now the young handsome man is dead, just like everyone else in the kingdom. Babylon leaves the bar, returns to the hotel room. When she drinks the liquor in the glass, it represents the blood of the saints and pagan people she has killed. When she puts on black and white clothing, it represents the black and white nature of the Lord.

Finally there is the elevator. The elevator represents the path for a soul and where their eternity is going to be. There are only two directions for elevators. Up and down. Pay close attention to what direction the elevator goes after Babylon takes the lives of her victims.

There are many expressions of death and several who bear its tittle. One is holy one is unholy. Physical death hurts and can be sudden and devastation, but if the person is saved, they are fine and gain eternal life. If the person was never saved to begin with or sold their salvation for corruption, their spiritual death will be dark and they will go down to The Pit, enter Sheol, be a prisoner of Hell and be a cut off from Elohim. Forever. Do not fall for Babylon's tricks. Do not put yourself into a situation where she can kiss and seduce you and do not eat at her table simply because it's easier. She will eventually come to collect when she's done with you and when that happens, it's too late to change sides.

It's too late to say, "Lord I'm sorry. Give another chance!"

The cross was that chance, the Book they left behind for us to read is that chance. The door to our heart doesn't have a handle. It only produces a handle if we openly and willingly want to get up and open the door to embrace the person on the other side. Before you let the person knocking come inside your house and live with you, make sure you test the spirit who claims they are holy or the Lord. Put what that spirit says and does to scripture and watch them closely. If their actions and words doesn't align with the holiness of the Lord, don't believe the woman or man wearing black and white clothes, don't let their pretty eyes and their red, succulent lips that curl into a smirk convince you that their path will be right for you.

All paths they offer you come with cons, red tape and oh yeah—a hidden trail of blood. Don't forget that the people in their kingdom are dead men and women walking and the main course they want to serve at their table is, that's right, you guessed it. You. If you choose to let those imposters inside, you will be a dead man or woman walking until Hell decides one day, that they're done with you and done living inside of you. When that happens, you will surely die, so be wise and choose life and flee from that adulterous woman, Lucifer and their army of devils for one, obvious truth that I hope you take seriously and never forget. Hell. Isn't. Worth. Death.
